Free School Meals and Free Uniform

Please remember to register for Free School Meals if you are eligible. All children from **Reception to Year 6** who are eligible for **Benefit Related Free School Meals** will be given a **free school uniform**. This will include a cardigan or jumper and a school bag. **This is only available if your child is registered**



and we receive notification from the Free School Meals Department in September. Children in receipt of benefit related Free School Meals will also get the cost of their residential trips at a reduced rate. Please pop into the office to speak to Miss Galasso or Mrs Cresswell and they will give you a form to place your order. The free uniform does not apply to children from Reception to Year 2 who are eligible for the Universal Free School Meals, (unless they are on **Benefit Related Free School Meals.**)
