### Free School Meals and Free Uniform

Please remember to register for Free School Meals if you are eligible. All children from **Reception to Year 6** who are eligible for **Benefit Related Free School Meals** will be given a **free school uniform**.

This will include a cardigan or jumper and a school bag. **This is only available if your child is registered and we receive notification from**

**the Free School Meals Department in September.** Children in receipt of benefit related Free School Meals will also get the cost of their residential trips at a reduced rate. Please pop into the office to speak to Miss Galasso or Mrs Cresswell and they will give you a form to place your order. The free uniform does not apply to children from Reception to Year 2 who are eligible for the Universal Free School Meals, (unless they are on **Benefit Related Free School Meals**.) **To find out if you are eligible for FSM please ring 0300 123 7039.**
