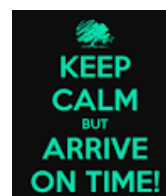


### After school Clubs

<b>5 minutes late each day</b>	<b>3 days lost!</b>
<b>10 minutes late each day</b>	<b>6.5 days lost!</b>
<b>15 minutes late each day</b>	<b>10 days lost!</b>
<b>20 minutes late each day</b>	<b>13 days lost!</b>
<b>30 minutes late each day</b>	<b>19 days lost!</b>
