It is characterized by normal early growth and development followed by a slowing of development, loss of

purposeful use of the hands, distinctive hand movements, slowed brain and head growth, problems with walking, seizures, and intellectual disability. We are asking for a donation of **50p per child or £1.00 per family towards the charity**.
